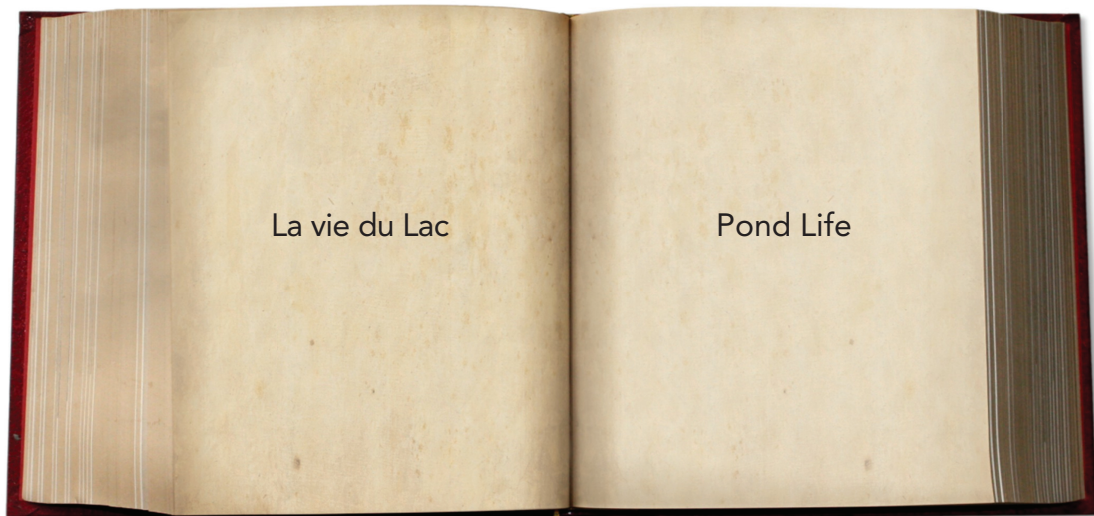

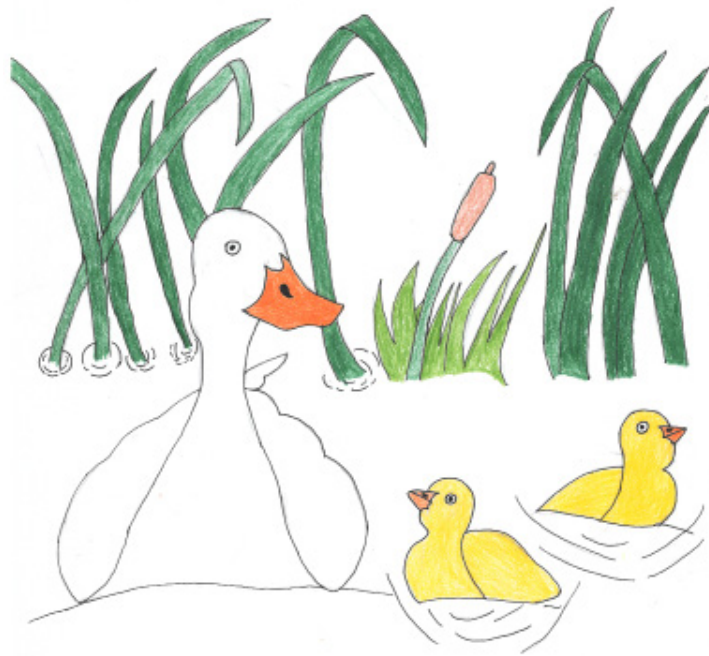
Close to the shore we see tadpoles
